THINGS TO DO NEAR GROTON

USS Nautilus & Submarine Force Library & Museum

Tour the USS Nautilus, the world's first nuclear-powered submarine, and explore fascinating exhibits on U.S. naval and submarine history. This is one of the most unique military museums in the country and a must-see in Groton.



Bluff Point State Park

A beautiful coastal preserve offering hiking, biking, birdwatching, and shoreline views of Long Island Sound. The trails wind through forests, salt marshes, and beaches — perfect for outdoor lovers and photographers.



Fort Griswold Battlefield State Park

Step back into Revolutionary War history at the site of the 1781 Battle of Groton Heights. Walk the historic grounds, climb the Groton Monument for views, and enjoy a peaceful park with deep historical significance.



Mystic Seaport Museum & Mystic Aquarium (Mystic)

Mystic Seaport Museum is a living maritime village with historic ships, craftspeople, & hands-on exhibits. Mystic Aquarium features beluga whales, penguins, sharks, & marine conservation exhibits. Together, they make Mystic one of the best day trips in New England.

Foxwoods Resort Casino & Mohegan Sun

Two of the largest casinos in the U.S., that offer far more than gambling are only about 20 minutes away. World-class restaurants and nightlife, live concerts, comedy, sports events, luxury shopping and spas.



The Dinosaur Place – Nature's Art Village (Great for families)

A fun, outdoor adventure park with life-size dinosaur trails, splash pads, and nature walks. Ideal for families with kids or anyone looking for a playful, relaxed day outdoors.


Noank Village & Fisherman's Memorial


Garde Arts Center (New London – 10 min)

ABOUT THIS AREA

Groton, CT is a historic coastal town best known for its deep naval roots, scenic shoreline, & access to southeastern Connecticut's most popular attractions. Situated along the Thames River & Long Island Sound, Groton blends maritime history, quiet seaside villages, & expansive parks with easy access to nearby destinations like Mystic, New London, & Stonington. The surrounding area offers a mix of charming waterfront towns, cultural venues, beaches, casinos, & preserved natural spaces, making the region ideal for both relaxed coastal exploration & lively entertainment.

GETTING AROUND



SEAT (Southeast Area Transit District) Local Bus Service

SEAT operates fixed-route buses through Groton and nearby towns, including local routes (like Route 11) that serve key areas such as Groton Square, Grasso Gardens, Walmart, and Pequot Medical Center.



HOP Microtransit (On-Demand Local Service)

An on-demand, flexible rideservice provided by SEAT that connects neighborhoods, shopping centers, employers, and community locations throughout Groton and neighboring towns — bookable via smartphone app.



Rideshare Services (Uber/Lyft)

Uber (and Lyft where available) operates throughout the Groton area, letting you request rides on demand or schedule rides ahead of time.



Car Rentals

Renting a car gives the most flexibility for exploring Groton and the surrounding region. You can rent vehicles from agencies at Groton-New London Airport (GON) or nearby hubs, with major brands like Enterprise, Hertz, Budget, and Avis available.



Train Access via New London or Mystic

Nearby towns of New London and Mystic offer rail service on Amtrak and the Shore Line East commuter line, connecting the region to larger cities like New Haven, Stamford, and beyond.



Air Travel via Regional Airports

The closest small airport is Groton-New London Airport (GON) (general aviation), but for commercial flights you'd typically use Bradley International Airport (Hartford: 1 hr away) or T.F. Green Airport (Providence, RI: 45–60 min), reachable by car or rideshare

On the Waterfront Restaurant & Bar is a family-owned seafood and American restaurant located on the Thames River in New London, Connecticut. Known for its casual elegance and waterfront dining.

Captain Scott's Lobster Dock- New London
